**WHEREAS**, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, a public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on June 19, 2017 at 7:00 pm, before the Village Board of Dupo and notice of said hearing was duly given; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has the authority pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208 to require the placement of a stop sign to assign right-of-way to traffic on certain approaches at any intersection of streets under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has determined that the placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Muskopf Place and Gladys Avenue is in the best interest to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Dupo, Illinois;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One:** The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board, and incorporated herein.

**Section Two:** The placement of a stop sign at the intersection of Muskopf Place and Gladys Avenue is in the best interest to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Dupo, Illinois.

**Section Three:** The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

**Section Four:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

**PASSED** this 19th day of June, 2017 by the Village Mayor and the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, and deposited and filed in the office of the Village Clerk in said Village on that date.
