**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE II, DIVISION IV, SECTION 1-2-27
OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS' ADMINISTRATION CODE PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupu, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held in the Village of Dupu, Illinois at the Dupu Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on October 2, 2017 at 7:00 pm, before the Village Board of Dupu and notice of said meeting was duly given; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has recently amended Section 5/8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1) increasing the threshold amount of requiring bidding of work or other public improvement to \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, it was brought before the Village Board that it would be in the best interests of the Village of Dupu to consider increasing the amount in its Code of Ordinances to reflect that amount prescribed by state law; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees believe that the aforementioned increase to be in the best interest of the Village and its citizens, and to bring the Village's Code of Ordinances in-line with state law; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dupu, Illinois has recommended the approval of said amendment to Section 1-2-27 of its Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupu, Illinois to reflect the increase in the threshold amount that would require bidding as contained therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: Recitals. The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board, and incorporated herein.

Section 2: Amendment. Chapter 1, Article II, Division IV, Section 1-2-27 shall be amended as follows:

1-2-27 BIDDING AND CONTRACT PROCEDURES.

(B) Formal Contract Procedure. All work or other public improvement which is not to be paid for in whole or in part by special assessment or

special taxation, and all purchases, orders or contracts for supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services except as otherwise provided herein, when the estimated cost thereof shall exceed ~~Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)~~ **Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00)**, shall be purchased from the lowest responsible bidder, after due notice inviting bids, unless competitive bidding is waived by a vote of **two-thirds (2/3)** of the Trustees then holding office.

(J) **Open Market Procedure.** All work and purchases of supplies, materials and services of less than the estimated value of ~~Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)~~ **Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00)** shall be made in the open market, without newspaper advertisement and without observing the procedure prescribed by this Section for the award of formal contracts.

The Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupo, Illinois shall reflect such amendment.

Section 3: Severability of Provisions. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.


Section 4: Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: Effective. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Village Board of Trustees.


