RESOLUTION NO. 19-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS TO INCREASE VILLAGE PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS' RATE OF PAY

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois ("Village"), is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on February 5, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Dupo; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 30-2-32 of the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances the "Village may employ part-time police officers from time to time as they deem necessary;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 30-2-5 of the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances the compensation of those persons who work for the Village's Police Department shall receive such compensation as provided by Village ordinance or by resolution of the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Dupo, Illinois (the Village Board and Mayor) have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village, its citizens and the general public, and that in order to retain adequate and sufficiently trained part-time police officers within the Village that the rate in which the Village compensates part-time police officers should be increased from \$14.00 per hour to \$17.00 per hour for officers who have fully completed the requisite police academy training; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the recitals set forth above in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as recommendations of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Dupo, Illinois.
- 2. That as of this date of this Resolution the rate in which part-time police officers are compensated shall be increased from \$14.00 per hour to \$17.00 per hour for officers who have fully completed the requisite police academy training.
- 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
