AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 21, ARTICLE II, SECTION 21-2-6(A) OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS' REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois "Village" at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on April 16, 2018 at 7:00 pm, before the Village Board of Trustees of Dupo and notice of said meeting was duly given; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees has determined there that there is a need to increase the number of Class A-1 liquor licenses that are available for purchase in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances, specifically section 21-2-6(A), currently provides that "[t]here shall be no more than (6) [Class A-1] licenses issued at any one (1) time"; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Trustees desires and recommends increasing the number of Class A-1 liquor licenses from six (6) to eight (8) in total; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dupo, Illinois has recommended the approval of said amendment to section 21-2-6(A) of the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances, and thus, increasing the total number of Class A-1 liquor licenses available in the Village to eight (8); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS:

- **Section 1:** Recitals. The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board, and incorporated herein.
- **Section 2:** Amendment. The request for an amendment to Chapter 21, Article II, Section 21-2-6(A) of the Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupo, Illinois as follows (deletion indicated by strikethrough and addition indicated in *bold and italics*):
 - **21-2-6** CLASSES OF LICENSES; TERM; ANNUAL FEES. Every person, firm, or corporation engaged in the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in the Village shall pay an annual fee. Such licenses shall be divided into the following classes:
 - (A) Class "A-1" License: Taverns, Etc. with Closing at 1:00 A.M. Class "A-1" licenses which shall authorize retail sale of alcoholic liquor whether in the original package or otherwise for consumption on the premises, as well as for

consumption off the premises. The Class "A-1" license shall allow the licensee to sell or offer for sale at retail, or to give away in or upon the Class "A-1" licensed premises any alcoholic liquor between the hours of 6:00 A.M. through 1:00 A.M. the next morning. The annual fee for such application shall be Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00). There shall be no more than six (6) eight (8) licenses issued at any one (1) time.

is APPROVED. The Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupo, Illinois shall reflect such amendment.

Section 3: Severability of Provisions. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section 4: Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: Effective. This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Village Board of Trustees.
