RESOLUTION FOR TAX ABATEMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo has previously passed Ordinance No. 06-05 on April 20, 2006, same being an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Authorizing and Directing of the Issuance of Nine Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$950,000.00) Alternate Revenue Bonds of the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois; Prescribing the Form and Details of said Bonds; and Providing for the Levy of the Tax for the Payment of Said Bonds, both as to Principal and Interest"; and

WHEREAS, no tax revenue is required for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds for the fiscal year 2018-2019.




