AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF TWO TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (CHILDREN AT PLAY SIGNS) ALONG NORTH FOURTH STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Junior and Senior High School, 600 Louisa Avenue, on October 19, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Dupo, and such meeting was held in person with remote access due to the Governor's Executive Orders pertaining to the COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/7(e)(4), and such allowed for remote attendance by the public and the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, the Village has the authority pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-208 to require the placement of "Children at Play" signs to place drivers on notice of potential children who may enter the street;

WHEREAS, the Village has determined that The placement of two "Children at Play" signs along 100 block of North Fourth Street, specifically at the intersection of North Fourth Street and Emma Street and the intersection of North Fourth Street and Lindeman Street, in the Village of Dupo, Illinois is in the best interest to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Dupo, Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board and incorporated herein.

Section Two: The placement of two "Children at Play" signs along 100 block of North Fourth Street, specifically at the intersection of North Fourth Street and Emma Street and the intersection of North Fourth Street and Lindeman Street, in the Village of Dupo, Illinois is in the best interest to public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Dupo, Illinois.

<u>Section Three</u>: The various portions of this Ordinance are hereby expressly declared to be severable, and the invalidity of any such portion of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portions of this Ordinance, which shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
