ORDINANCE NO. 21-03

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SEMI-TRUCKS ON THE 100 BLOCK OF DYROFF STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on March 1, 2021 at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Dupo, and such meeting was held remotely due to the Governor's Executive Orders pertaining to the COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/7(e)(4), and such allowed for remote attendance by the public and the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-80-2, the Village of Dupo has the authority to regulate the use of the streets in the municipality; and pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/15-316(c), the Village of Dupo has the authority to prohibit the operation of trucks or other commercial vehicles, as well as impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highways under its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, Dyroff Street is a street located within the Village of Dupo that connects Main Street with several other residential streets; and

WHEREAS, due to excessive driving of semi-trucks, the 100 block of Dyroff Street has and continues to sustain regular and systematic damage that requires costly repair and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of protecting the public safety as well as municipal infrastructure, the Corporate Authorities find it necessary to prohibit the use of semi-trucks on the 100 block of Dyroff Street, Dupo, Illinois, with the exception of municipal or authorized vehicles that may need to use said street on particular occasions; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Dupo, Illinois hereby find that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to prohibit the use of semi-trucks on Dyroff Street, Dupo, Illinois, with the exception of municipal or authorized vehicles that are owned, operated or authorized by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: Recitals. The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board and incorporated herein.

- **Section 2:** <u>Semi-Trucks Prohibited.</u> It is hereby prohibited to operate Semi-Trucks on the 100 block of Dyroff Street, beginning at the intersection of Main Street and Dyroff Street and continuing to the intersection of Dyroff Street and Second Street, in the Village of Dupo.
- Section 3. Signs. The Village shall hereafter place signs on the 100 block of Dyroff Street, beginning at the intersection of Main Street and Dyroff Street and continuing to the intersection of Dyroff Street and Second Street, in sufficient number and spacing so as to give sufficient notice.
- **Section 4:** <u>Severability of Provisions.</u> Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.
- **Section 5:** Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- Section 6: Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
