### ORDINANCE NO. 21-10

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1-2-24 AND CHAPTER 1-2-79 OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS' REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE REQUIRED BOND OF THE VILLAGE TREASURER

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on July 6, 2021 at 7:00 pm, before the Village Board of Dupo, and such meeting was held in accordance with the Governor's Executive Orders pertaining to the COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/7(e)(4), and such allowed for in person and remote attendance by the public and the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS**, it was brought before the Village Board that it would be in the best interests of the Village of Dupo to amend two sections of Chapter 1 of Administration in the Village of Dupo Revised Code, specifically, Sections 1-2-24 and 1-2-79; and

WHEREAS, Sections 1-2-24 and 1-2-79 are currently in conflict and do not represent the current needs of the Village of Dupo's bonding and authorization requirements for the Village Treasurer.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees desire that Section 1-2-24 be amended to change the Treasurer's bond amount to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) in 1-2-24(A)(2), striking the previous amount of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) and inserting in its place five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees desire that Section 1-2-79 be amended by striking and removing the current language, and amending the entirety of 1-2-79 as follows:

1-2-79 BOND. The Treasurer shall give bond conditioned upon the faithful performance of his or her duties and to indemnify the Village for any loss due to neglect of duty or wrongful act on his or her part; and the amount of such bond shall not be less than \$500,000 and the Treasurer shall not have the right, ability, or authority to individually sign a Village of Dupo check or make any withdrawal or transfer of Village funds for an amount over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) without a second Village official(s) signature. That in the case of a check, withdrawal, or transfer of Village funds in an amount over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), the Treasurer shall obtain, and is required to obtain, a second signature as authorized and required by this provision. The authority to commit, act, and sign as the second required signatory rests first on the Mayor. If the Mayor is not able to sign the check, withdrawal, or transfer, then the Village Clerk is authorized to commit, act, and sign as the second signatory. If neither the Mayor or the Village Clerk are able to sign the check, withdrawal, or transfer, then two Board Members are authorized to commit, act, and sign as the second signatories.

WHEREAS, that the now Sections 1-2-24 and 1-2-79 be amended as stated above for all future use; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees believe that the aforementioned changes to be in the best interests of the Village and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dupo, Illinois has recommended the approval of said amendments to its Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupo, Illinois to reflect this reorganization of its Code.

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Treasurer shall notify all financial institutions holding funds of the Village of Dupo of this amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board and incorporated herein.

Section Two: This request for an amendment to Chapter 1 Administrative Sections 1-2-24 and 1-2-79 of the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances, shall be amended and inserted into the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances. This Amendment is APPROVED. The Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupo, Illinois shall reflect such amendments.

<u>Section Three</u>: Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

Section Four: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Five: This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Village Board of Trustees.
