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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE  
VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE III  
AMENDING THE VILLAGE'S SEWER RATES

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois ("Village"), is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on October 4, 2021, at 7:00 pm, before the Village Board of Dupo and notice of said meeting was duly given; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances, Section 32-3-4 (Basic User Rate), the Village has established certain charges and rates for the use of the Village's public wastewater system; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that the costs of periodically upgrading, repairing, and maintaining the public wastewater system of the Village has increased, as well as the costs and expenses in treating wastewater (i.e., chemical costs, etc.); and

WHEREAS, after careful investigation, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to amend Section 32-3-4 of Chapter 32, Article III of the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances, by increasing the Basic User Rates as follows: a 9.7% increase of the rate for usage in excess of 2,000 gallons; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees desire that Section 32-3-4, shall be amended to read as follows:

**32-3-4 BASIC USER RATE.** In addition to any other service charge(s) as required by the Village's Revised Code Ordinances, a user of the wastewater facility shall pay (a) the sum of Nineteen Dollars and Seven Cents (\$19.07) per month as a minimum charge and (b) for each month that the users water consumption exceeds two thousand (2,000) gallons, such user shall pay the sum of ~~Four Dollars and Forty one Cents (\$4.41)~~ **Four Dollars and Eighty-four Cents (\$4.84)** for each one thousand (1,000) gallons used in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees have determined that the aforementioned amendment to the Basic User Rate (32-3-4) is to take effect on November 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees believe that the aforementioned amendment to be in the best interests of the Village and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of Dupu, Illinois has recommended the approval of said amendment to the Village's Revised Code of Ordinances of Dupu, Illinois;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, ILLINOIS:

**Section 1: Recitals.** The aforementioned recitals are hereby adopted as findings by the Village Board and incorporated herein.

**Section 2: Amendments.** Chapter 32 (Sewer System), Article III, Section 32-3-4 (Basic User Rate) shall now hereinafter read as follows:

**32-3-4 BASIC USER RATE.** In addition to any other service charge(s) as required by the Village's Revised Code Ordinances, a user of the wastewater facility shall pay (a) the sum of Nineteen Dollars and Seven Cents (\$19.07) per month as a minimum charge and (b) for each month that the users water consumption exceeds two thousand (2,000) gallons, such user shall pay the sum of Four Dollars and Eighty-four Cents (\$4.84) for each one thousand (1,000) gallons used in excess of two thousand (2,000) gallons.

**Section 3: Severability of Provisions.** Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

**Section 4: Conflict.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


**Section 5: Effective.** This Ordinance shall take full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Village Board of Trustees; however, the increase in the Basic User Rate (32-3-4) as stated above shall be effective on the Village's sewer customers/users as of November 1, 2021.
