RESOLUTION NO. 22-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF DUPO, IL, TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RELIABLE SANITATION SERVICE

WHEREAS, the Village of Dupo, St. Clair County, Illinois, is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a duly noticed public meeting was held in the Village of Dupo, Illinois at the Dupo Village Hall, 107 N. Second Street, on November 7, 2022 at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Dupo; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Dupo, Illinois believe it necessary and in the Village's best interests to dispose, remove, and transport the Village's solid waste and recyclables; and

WHEREAS, Reliable Sanitation Service desires and has agreed to remove and transport the Village's solid waste and recyclables as contained in, and pursuant to the terms and conditions in the Contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Dupo, Illinois hereby find that it is necessary, advisable and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to authorize the entering into the aforementioned Contract with Reliable Sanitation Service for the proper disposal, removal, and transport of the Village's solid waste and recyclables; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the recitals set forth above in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as recommendations of the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Dupo, Illinois.
- 2. That the Mayor on behalf of the Village of Dupo, Illinois is hereby authorized to contract with Reliable Sanitation Service to remove and transport the Village's solid waste and recyclables pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Contract attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- 3. That the Mayor of the Village of Dupo, Illinois, on behalf of the Village, and the Village Clerk to seal, if necessary, are hereby authorized to execute the Contract between the Village and Reliable Sanitation Service that is contained in Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.

4. That the Mayor and Village Clerk of the Village of Dupo, Illinois are further authorized to provide any such additional information as may be required to accomplish the Contract between the Village and Reliable Sanitation Service.

Proposal

Option 1.

Proposer to provide Fully Automated Solid Waste & Recyclable Collection Service:

Year 1

11/1/22 to 10/31/23

Cost per month per resident \$15.88

Senior Rate \$15.38 /month.

PROPOSED FULLY AUTOMATED TRASH AND RECYCLE SERVICES DESCRIPTION

- Each residential unit is provided two (2) 95-gallon wheeled containers at no charge.
- One (1) container shall be used for Solid Waste and the other container will be "marked" and used for Recyclables.
- The Solid Waste container will be collected weekly on the resident's normal collection day.
- The Recyclable container will be collected weekly on the resident's normal collection day.
- The proposer will collect solid waste and recyclable containers with a specially designed truck(s) capable of mechanically lifting and dumping the wheeled containers.
- Set trash and recycling containers out by 6:00 a.m. on collection day.
- Set containers as close to the curb as possible with a minimum distance of five (5) feet apart.
- Continue to bag all trash items.
- With option of 65-gallon wheeled containers for solid waste or Recyclables instead of 95gallon for small or senior households.
- This agreement shall be in effect from November 1, 2022 to October 31, 2025. After the initial on (1) year term, the monthly charge shall be increased by an amount equal to the percentage of increase of change in the "all Items Category" of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers as published by the Bureau of Labor statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The monthly charge shall annually be adjusted upward to reflect said C.P.I. or 3%, whichever is greater.

Option 2

<u>Private Yard Waste Subscription Collection Service</u> for nine (9) months. The residents can contract directly with the proposer and receive the following rates:

Year 1 11/1/22 to 10/31/23 \$24.60 Cost per resident

EXISTING PRIVATE SUBSCRIPTION YARD WASTE SERVICES DESCRIPTION

- Residents contract directly with Proposer.
- Yard waste is offered per quarter (3 month period) with a minimum sign up of one quarter.
- Yard waste service provides maximum collection of ten (10) paper biodegradable bags (no plastic bags) or 32 gallon trash cans.
- If trash cans are used for yard waste, they must be marked with a 2'x2' red "X" and placed as close to roadway as possible or they will not be collected.
- Bags or cans of yard waste are not to exceed 50 lbs in weight.
- Sticks and twigs up to 4" diameter will be collected in 2'x4' bundles tied with twine.
- Yard waste collection will not be performed in the months of January, February, and March.
- Yard waste is collected weekly on the resident's normal trash & recyclables collection day.
- This agreement shall be in effect from November 1, 2022 to October 31, 2025. After the initial on (1) year term, the monthly charge shall be increased by an amount equal to the percentage of increase of change in the "all Items Category" of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers as published by the Bureau of Labor statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The monthly charge shall annually be adjusted upward to reflect said C.P.I. or 3%, whichever is greater.

NO Charge services – The following services will be provided at No additional charge to the Village of Dupo:

- 1. The proposer will provide up to Fourteen (14) 95-gallon wheeled containers for the Village annual July 4th and for the Fall Festival. Each are once a year event.
- 2. The proposer agrees to provide and maintain the necessary residential solid waste and/or recyclable containers depending upon acceptance of the chosen option(s).
